## JUANITA TREBILCOCK

**JUANITA TREBILCOCK** was the daughter of Wallis Trebilcock (1883 - 1952) and Lucy Goldine "Goldie" Gove (1887 - 1978). Juanita was born on 20 Feb 1913 in Dodge City, Ford County, Kansas. When she was a child, she lived with her parents in Ford, Ford County, Kansas. In 1932, they moved to Gray County, Kansas. There, in 1936, Juanita wrote several stories about the area and its pioneers, for the Federal Writers Project.

By 1940, Juanita had moved to Topeka, Kansas, and worked as a file clerk for the Kansas Unemployment Bureau. There she met **EARL LEROY FAITH**, son of John R. Faith (1872 - 1953) and Harriet "Hattie" Anna Allen (1877 - 1960). Earl was born on 18 Jan 1906. They married on 17 May 1941 in Pulaski County, Arkansas. They had one child, a daughter, **LINDA FAITH**.

Earl and Juanita left Topeka, Kansas, sometime after 1952, moving to Denver, Denver County, Colorado. Earl died on 27 Dec 1974. Juanita passed away on 25 Oct 1984 in Denver. Their burial was at the Fort Logan National Cemetery in Denver, Denver County, Colorado.
